SCHEDULE

The Fair opens Wednesday April 22, 1964 and closes after 180 days, on October 18, 1964. It will reopen Wednesday April 21, 1965, operate 180 more days and close October 17, 1965. The Fair will run daily including Sundays and holidays.

Gates to the Fairgrounds will open at 9:30 a.m. The exhibits will open at 10:00 a.m. and close between 10:00 p.m. and mid-night. Many restaurants, shows, amusement concessions, bars and nightclubs will remain open until 2:00 a.m.

ADMISSIONS

An admission lickel is required ular gate price for each visit to the fair. The regular gate price for tickels is \$2.00 each for adults and \$1.00 each for children (age 2 through 12).
