




An estimated 100 million visitors from all over the world will come to the 1964-1965 NEW YORK WORLD'S FAIR - by far the greatest box office attraction in history.






The theme of the Fair, and the purpose of the Inventions Exhibit, is to present to the world an exposition of man's achievements in an expanding Universe.






