


A SEARCH FOR MEANING AND PURPOSE...

The 200-inch telescope atop Mount Palomar in southern California is called the "window on the universe." On sensitive photographic film it has recorded the light of literally millions of stars, many of them in distant galaxies millions of light-years from the earth. Many astronomers believe that these "island universes" are the same age; that they all started from the same place at the same time—a significant observation in the light of Genesis 1:1, "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth."






MAN WAS CREATED IN THE IMAGE OF GOD


Setting for Mr. Graham's account of creation is a forest of California redwoods called "man's oldest living things"

"The Son of Man is come to seek and to save that which was lost."


"All power is given unto me in heaven and earth." "Heaven and earth shall pass away but my words shall not pass away."


We can never be neutral about the claims of Christ. He is the one who said, "I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved."

"I am the light of the world: he that follows me shall not walk in darkness."






HE CAME TO REDEEM ...

HE IS RISEN ... AND IS COMING AGAIN


On the morning of the third day after he was crucified, three women went to his tomb to anoint the body with spices. They were the first to hear the most dramatic announcement the human ear has ever heard: "He is not here! He is risen!"

"I am he that lives and was dead," Christ said. "I am alive for evermore, ... And because I live, you shall live also."

For the first time since sin entered the human race there was hope for mankind.

From the Mount of Olives above Jerusalem, just before he ascended into heaven, Christ gave a command to the eyewitnesses of his resurrection: "Go ye into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature." Then he was taken up out of their sight; and the Bible says that two messengers from heaven said to the disciples, "This same Jesus shall so come in like manner as you have seen him go into heaven."

The Bible teaches us that Jesus Christ is coming to earth again. When Christ prayed, "Thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven," he knew that the prayer would ultimately be answered, that God's Kingdom would prevail some day. Yes, there is coming a day of worldwide peace; not through the efforts of man alone... but by the authority and power of the Christ who ascended from the Mount of Olives almost 2,000 years ago!



A VOICE IN THE MARKET PLACE...

The reality of Christ's resurrection power became the explosive dynamic that thrust the early believers out of Jerusalem and into the teeming Roman Empire. None was more prolific than the Apostle Paul, whose burning convictions drove him to the far corners of the Mediterranean world.

Foundations for the Space Age of the 21st century were laid during the Golden Age of Greece, when the sciences of astronomy, mathematics, medicine—and many other tools of man's quest for knowledge—were initiated. Little wonder that Paul's words to first-century Athens are equally relevant to the mind of man today:

"Gentlemen of Athens! While it is true that God has overlooked the days of (man's spiritual) ignorance, he now commands all men everywhere to repent. For he has fixed a day on which he will judge the whole world in justice by the standard of a man whom he has appointed. That this is so he has guaranteed to all men by raising this man from the dead."









AN UNENDING
PROCESSION
OF WITNESSES...

Down through the centuries, whenever men and women of any culture have honestly approached the mystery of the cross, they have encountered the Spirit of the living Christ. The message of forgiveness, comfort and hope has transformed men in every generation.

Augustine was reared in the fourthcentury paganism of the Roman Empire . . . witty, willful, sensual, a skeptic... the story of Augustine is the story of human nature. "I sought a way of obtaining strength sufficient to enjoy God; and found it not until I embraced that Mediator betwixt God and men, the Man Christ Jesus!"

Pascal, French physicist and mathematician, set the 17th century on fire with his personal convictions about Jesus Christ. "Not only do

we know God by Jesus Christ alone, but we know ourselves only by Jesus Christ. Apart from him we do not know what is our life, nor our death, nor ourselves."

"War and Peace" brought the Russian novelist Leo Tolstoy permanent fame as a literary artist. Shortly before completing "Anna Karenina," he entered a period of profound searching as to the pur-



pose of life . . . a search that led him to Christ. "When I came to believe in Christ's teaching, I ceased desiring what I had wished for before. The direction of my life, my desires, became different. What was good and bad changed places."

The early days of America reflect the faith of our nation's founding fathers: Their courage and high purpose stemmed from a strong awareness of man's spiritual need and an abiding faith in the promises of God.

Remember the scene of George Washington on his knees in prayer at Valley Forge. And the letter Benjamin Franklin wrote to the Speaker of the Senate asking that the Constitutional Congress begin each day with prayer. Those were days when this country was being born...





FAITH OF OUR FATHERS

The driving force behind our Constitution, the Bill of Rights, and the Declaration of Independence-was faith in God. Our forefathers stamped this faith on our coins-they put Bibles in our courtrooms-they opened the Congress with prayer-they instituted the custom of having our President take the oath of office with his hand on the Bible. It was this faith and this Book which largely gave birth to our concept of freedom.


During those last brief months of his Presidency, Lincoln said of the Bible: "All the good the Savior gave to the world is communicated through this Book. But for it we could not know right from wrong. All things most desirable for man's welfare are to be found portraved in it."

WHAT OF THE 20TH CENTURY?

There are those who say, "This faith was all right in the first century, but what about this scientific age in which we live today? Is the Bible still relevant and trustworthy? Can the Gospel of Christ transform modern man?" From the realm of letters, industry and psychiatry, three contemporaries reply.



Calvin D. Linton, Dean of Arts and Sciences, George Washington University:

"Our neat little predictable world is vanishing, and man is becoming more and more a lonely creature in the universe, doubting his mastery even of his own environment.

"Our fear of physical death has been transcended by a greater fear, that of total meaninglessness. I believe man must descend the stairs of his self-conceit—and learn to be still! Only then can he hear the words of the One by whom the worlds were made . . . the One who declared, I am the way, the truth and the life; no man cometh unto the Father but by me.'

"Only the heart that puts its trust in this Jesus of history and of eternity can face today's world and today's universe without fear!"





Elmer Engstrom, President of R.C.A.:

"With the understanding we are developing through science, can we within this understanding conceive of how a Supreme Being could dip his hands into the affairs of men and of the world to influence and to control what takes place? To this I give a definite answer of yes.

"Ibelieve that one who is committed to Jesus Christ as his or her Lord and Master has an assurance and a satisfaction in ongoing affairs that is not known by those who are not Christ's followers.

"With Christ as my Master and as the Lord of history, living is for me a glorious experience and adventure in his service." Armand M. Nicholi, Jr., M.D., Senior Staff Psychiatrist, Harvard University:

"We live in an age of an explosive increase of knowledge; yet for the mass of men the basic questions remain unanswered. How does one find direction and purpose in life? How does one face death? Many are turning to psychiatry for answers. but psychiatry is primarily concerned with deepening man's understanding of the functioning of the mind-not so much with his purpose and destiny. Christianity is concerned precisely with these questions. Christ brings, to each life committed to him, direction, purpose, and understanding of who we are and why we are here. And when we face alone, as each of us must, the prospect of death, Christ's death and resurrection become profoundly meaningful. He replaces fear, bitterness and despair with hope, faith and unspeakable comfort."

THE FIFTH DIMENSION...

Man's achievements in the expanding universe have been tremendous, but they have never really met our deepest need. Most of us long for a sense of forgiveness and an exhilaration that only God can give to the soul.

You know the Ten Commandments and the Sermon on the Mount. You would like to live that kind of life: but you lack the capacity and resources. You would like to love your neighbor, but you find you are incapable of loving him as you ought. It is this capacity and this dimension that is lacking in human nature. The Bible teaches that there is nothing in our sinful nature that can produce spiritual life. Christ said, "You must be born again." This is not reformation but regeneration. He wants to make you a completely new person.

But you say, "How can this happen to me? I know I have transgressed God's laws: I know I can't do anything about it in my own strength. How can I get rid of the guilt of the past and start life over?"


First, you must be willing to repent of sin. Repentance means that you change your mind about God and your relationship to him. Repentance involves also a willingness to change your whole pattern of living. Notice I said a "willingness." You may not have the strength or the ability to repent, but if you are willing. God will help you to repent.

Second, you must turn to Christ by simple faith and accept him as your Lord and Savior. Notice again, I said "by faith." If you wait until you can understand it all, you will never come. It must be a step of faith. It is like receiving a gift—the gift of pardon for the past and a new life for the future. Many of you have come with an emptiness and a rest-lessness in your heart and soul. Intellectually some of you are not certain about the purpose and

meaning of life. You have never really committed yourself to any great cause or purpose. You long to have something to believe in, a flag to follow, and a song to sing. Why not commit your life to Jesus Christ and let his love and authority dominate your life?

Others of you have been suffering from a sense of guilt. You would like to wake up tomorrow morning knowing that all the failure and sin of the past is completely gone—having a zest for life that only God can give. This tremendous change in your life could take place right here and now. A commitment to Christ is only the first step, but it is a necessary step if you are to enter the Kingdom of God.

I am asking you to take this step of faith right now. Open your heart to Christ. May this visit to the New York World's Fair mark the beginning of your life in the fifth dimension—the dimension of the spirit!



BALPH CARMICHAEL

Music Composer and Conductor

Every viewer of Man in the 5th Dimension will agree that a major contribution to the effectiveness of the motion picture is the music score, composed and conducted by Ralph Carmichael. Mr. Carmichael has performed similar assignments for World Wide Pictures, beginning with Mr. Texas, filmed during the Graham Crusade, Fort Worth, 1951.

The score for Man in the 5th Dimension, composed for 54 instruments and 28 voices, was recorded in Todd-AO 6-track stereo on the music stage of 20th Century-Fox Studios in West Los Angeles.



THE MIRACLE

TODD-AO is a revolutionary motion picture process in which the photographic methods and projection allow the audience to be a participant in every scene. The miracle of special lenses with 128 degrees of viewing angle and the curved screen provide realism and intimacy, using the principles by which the human eye sees.

The excitement of participation in the action is further heightened by the TODD-AO 6-channel sound system reproduced through five carefully spaced speakers behind the screen and a battery of "surround speakers" at the rear of the auditorium. The result to the viewer is the illusion of center seats in a great concert hall.

To the left on this page is a life-size reproduction of a strip of 70-millimeter film from Man in the 5th Dimension, showing the magnetic tracks on which the stereophonic sound is recorded on each side of the picture frames.

With the opening of the New York World's Fair, a new ministry is added to the evangelistic thrust of the Billy Graham association.
