Two goals have been pursued in assembling the present collection of paintings from Central America and Panama: to demonstrate the artistic evolution that has taken place in that area by examples of the work done by the younger generation; and to provide a view of the achievements of senior artists of established reputation, whose endeavors have been characterized by a continuous search for new values. Thus, such celebrated figures as Carlos Merida, of Guatemala, and Armando Morales, of Nicaragua, share honors with painters who are but now making their professional debuts.

All tendencies of relevance today are here represented, from primitivism to the sophistications of geometric abstraction. Avoided, however, are the topical, folkloric, anecdotal manifestations which long formed the bulk of production by some Latin American artists. These superficial, descriptive works resulted in an entirely false view by the American public of the talent and taste of a people whose aesthetic gifts had been clearly shown in many forms of artistic expression.
